Thank you for your interest in our IUD theory training for regional clinicians via webinar. The webinar lasts for 3 hours and the cost is dependent on enrolment numbers. IUD workshops cover current information about copper and hormonal IUD insertion and how to manage problems. It is expected that clinicians who undertake IUD insertion training have excellent skills in communication, helping patients to choose contraceptive methods, assessing suitability for IUD use, and pelvic examination.

For those who wish to become inserters, we suggest that you enquire amongst your networks for an experienced IUD supervisor who can supervise IUD clinical training. Clinical training should be done at a time when the skills can be put into practice immediately after the training.
