PIP respects your privacy

- Sometimes the law says PIP has to share information about you.
- Let PIP know of any changes to your information.
- Your information will be kept private and only discussed with PIP Staff and the people you name on the referral form.
- You have the right to access information about you.

In line with the Privacy Act, PIP will store all personal information in a secure manner to be accessed by authorised staff only. The programme will take reasonable steps to ensure that the information it collects, uses, or discloses is accurate, complete and up-to-date. Personal and sensitive information collected by PIP is not shared with other organisations or government bodies except where there is a legislative requirement to do so.

An individual has the right to access the personal details held and, if applicable, make a correctional statement to attach to the material, with a written request. When personal information is no longer required by the programme it will be disposed of confidentially.
