Purpose of form

This Financial Consent Form explains the costs of a medical termination of pregnancy (mTOP) procedure at Sexual Health Quarters (SHQ) for people without a Medicare card. It includes the estimated fees, possible extra costs and your financial responsibilities. By signing this form, you agree that you understand and accept these costs. This helps make sure everything is clear and you have a good experience with your healthcare.

Overview of treatment

Medical termination is an alternative to surgery for ending a pregnancy in the early weeks (up to 63 days). To see if this is suitable for you, you usually need an ultrasound to check the pregnancy's location and how far along it is. The procedure uses two medicines: mifepristone and misoprostol which come in a pack called MS-2 Step. You will also need regular blood tests to make sure the procedure is working.

Investigations To Assess Medical Termination Suitability

Pelvic Ultrasound Scan

An ultrasound scan is usually required to confirm the location and gestation of the pregnancy to assess suitability for a mTOP procedure.

Blood Test - Full Blood Count

A full blood test may be required to ensure that you are not anaemic and are suitable to proceed with a mTOP procedure.

Blood Test - Quantitative HCG

This test measures the pregnancy hormone levels in your blood. You will be required to have this tested at least twice during a straightforward mTOP procedure (at baseline and again at follow up). If there are any concerns about your pregnancy or mTOP procedure, you may be requested to have additional tests.

Medical Termination Procedure Appointment (SHQ)

Affordable medical abortion services are available at SHQ. Our staff are non-judgemental and are here to support you and your individual decision.

After your ultrasound and blood test results show you can safely take the medication, you will need an appointment to get a prescription for MS-2 Step. You will also get more information about the procedure and possible problems to watch for. You will also be given a prescription for pain relief and nausea.

Medication

MS-2 Step

Two medicines are used for mTOP. First, you take one mifepristone tablet. This stops the pregnancy from continuing. Then, after 36 to 48 hours, you take four misoprostol tablets. These help your body remove the pregnancy.

These medications are provided in Australia in a combination pack called MS-2 Step. Both mifepristone and misoprostol work together to end a pregnancy; it is important that you take both medications.

A combined prescription for pain relief and anti-nausea medicine to use during the mTOP procedure.

Follow Up Consultation (SHQ)

It is important that you attend a follow up appointment with your doctor after 1-2 weeks to ensure the medication has worked. Home pregnancy tests cannot be relied upon, as they can remain positive for many days after a pregnancy has ended. This follow-up is also a good time to discuss contraception with your doctor, as you can become pregnant again very soon after having an abortion.

Surgery

There is a 4 in 100 chance that some pregnancy tissue remains after an mTOP. This might need surgery to prevent infection and make sure the pregnancy ends.

In about 1% of cases, the pregnancy continues after mTOP. If this happens, we strongly recommend either surgery or another medical termination. If you decide to keep the pregnancy, the baby might have problems due to the medication misoprostol. The effects of mifepristone on the baby are not known.
