Non-Judgemental Clinic

Our friendly team of doctors and nurses have a high level of training in the area of sexual health. Come and see us about:



Contraception, including implants, intrauterine devices and more

Sexually transmissible infections (STIs) and Blood Borne Viruses (BBVs)



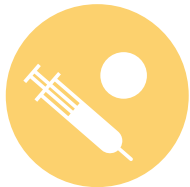
Cervical screening (clinician collect and self-collect options)

Unintended pregnancy options, including medical abortion



Preventative Care including vaccinations, PrEP and doxy-pep

Menopause support



Gender affirming care



If you have a Medicare card, you will have minimal out of pocket costs. People 18 and under and anyone with a Government concession/healthcare card and a valid Medicare card will have no out of pocket expense for a consultation appointment.

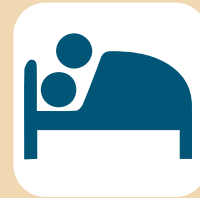

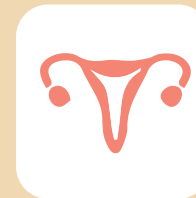
